WHY CONSIDER A RELATIONSHIP WITH AESA?

There are 500 Educational Service Agencies (ESAs), with over 200,000 employees in at least 40 states. AESA is in the position to reach 11,700 (**79%**) of the public school districts, 22,710 (**83%**) of the private schools, 2,160,955 (**79%**) certified teachers, and 2,018,888 (**80%**) non-certified school employees, and well over 40,732,954 (**80%**) public and private school students. This includes administrators, administrative support staff, instructional coordinators, principals, assistant principals, school librarians and support staff, instructional aides, guidance counselors, and other support and service staff members.

BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATION WITH AESA

ESAs are in face-to-face contact with nearly every superintendent and LEA key staff of local school districts on a weekly/monthly basis. As a result, ESA staff is acutely aware of the needs and problems faced by local public school districts, as well as private and parochial schools in their area along with other youth service agencies.


